## WHAT IS BEING DONE.

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance has directed \$50,000 dollars from the One Great Hour of Sharing funds toward the \$4.6 million effort by the Action by Churches Together (ACT) to bring humanitarian relief to this war-torn region. This relief consists of providing food and water, cooking utensils, bedding, sanitation supplies and other essential materials to women and children.

The Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, as a member of Action by Churches Together, is working with the Middle East Council of Churches and other partners to bring this much-needed relief. But more help is still urgently needed.
